Amazon has announced an update to the Fire HD 8, along with the new Fire HD 8 Plus and the new Fire HD 8 Kids Edition. Tablets still won't offer the software experience and performance that you get on more expensive tablets, but only at \$90 for the Fire HD 8, they're probably going to be hard to beat for the price - as we pointed out last year's Amazon Fire HD 10 review.
